
一月九日是學校的中文考試日,由於我考試前沒有認真温習,所以令我這次的 中文成績非常不理想。

謝婉雯醫生的一生短暫卻充滿光輝。她為救治病人奮不顧身而犧牲,就如她進醫學院時的誓言:「從醫是為了服務他人」,她做到了。謝醫生的一生深深地影響着後人,我也從中明白到:不要因為自身條件比不上別人便感到氣餒而輕易放棄,更不要為了個人私利而斤斤計較,我們要學習謝醫生,心懷無私精神,為社會努力奉獻。

Finally, put another half of the bun on the top.




Hungry Mary




First, when some children run in the library, they knock books down and hurt each other. I suggest the government put up signs to remind visitors.

An Unforgettable Day



A Kidnap



Are you more independent now than you were in Primary One?



<u>Lopburi Monkey Banquet – A Paradise Just For Monkey</u>


